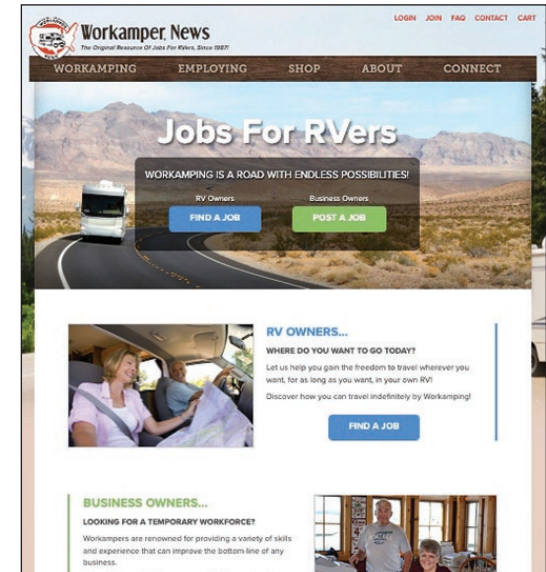

Member Map Profile

Connecting With Other Workampers

The Workamper Member Map Profile allows you to share a bit about yourself (or yourselves) with fellow members! Your Profile will only be seen by other Workamper members who click on your pin on the Member Map. The Profile is short and sweet, and will just take a few minutes to fill out.

There are two important things to note here:

- 1. EMPLOYERS DO NOT HAVE ACCESS.** Your Workamper Profile does not need to read like your Awesome Applicant resume.
- 2. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PARTICIPATE.** You do not have to have a profile to search and view other members' pins on the Member Map, nor to use other tools on the site.

Edit Your Profile. Click on the Member Map Profile button on your Dashboard. Type in information about yourself in the provided sections. Click the Save button when you're done! The View Your Profile button shows how others see your profile.

In addition to contact information, you'll put in an address for your current location. And further down you can say what your domicile/home base city/state is.

You can mention what RV and tow(ed) vehicle you have, plus write up a little about me section to share things like where you want to travel or have traveled, the Workamping job you're doing at your current location, travel companions, hobbies/interests, etc.!

Your profile is only viewable by fellow Workamper members, it is not open to the general public.

How do I find it:

When you log in to Workamper.com, you are taken to your Dashboard. On your Dashboard, click on My Profile.

Why I want to use it:

- If folks find and click on your pin on the Member Map, they'll get to see a bit more about you - which can help them confirm they know you or see what you have in common.

You only need to fill out your name and address in order for your pin to show on the map, but your fellow members would appreciate it if you shared a bit more about yourself!

Using the Map

Update and use often! Move your pin on the map as you travel. You can edit your pin location via the Member Map Profile page, or you can edit it right in the Map tool by clicking the edit my pin link.

A big benefit of this tool is you can research a Workamping job/employer. Search for the city, state of a job you're interested in. See which Workampers are located there. Contact them to see if they are working with that specific employer.

Click on a pin to see who it is and then click on "View Full Profile" link for any info they've shared.

You can use the fields in the sidebar to search on things like name, city, and state. Any results will display in a table beneath the search. You can click on a name to go to that person's pin.

Click on the Reset button to start your search over and go back to seeing all the pins on the map.

How do I find it:

When you log in to Workamper.com, you are taken to your Dashboard. On your Dashboard, click on Member Map.

Why I want to use it:

- Find fellow Workampers in your immediate area.
- Search and find your Workamper friends. See where they are and contact them to say hello!
- Research a potential Workamping position. Search for the city, state of a job you're researching. See which Workampers are located there. Contact them to see if they are working with that specific employer.

Employers do not have access to the map. You can search the map without having to share your location/add your pin.

Once you create and save your online resume it will be added into the database that is searched by our Employer members. They will contact you directly if they are interested. And you can easily email your AA resume to Employers you are interested in.

You can create and maintain your resume using the Resume Builder. There is a section for you to enter your Availability Date, so you can keep your resume active in the database all the time. There is also a box you can check to have your resume hidden from the database. **Employers can sort their search results by availability date and by the date you last edited your resume, so be sure to update often!**

If you are a couple/team, you will include everyone on one resume.

The Resume Builder is a step-by-step tool. You will see each step in a tab along the top. On the Home tab (Tab 1), you will see a button to email your resume and print your resume if you need to mail or fax a hard copy. You can also export your resume as a PDF file which can be emailed or used in an application process requiring you upload your resume.

Also shown is how many times your resume has been viewed, and when your resume was last updated. The Preview button will show you how Employers will see your resume.

As you are creating or editing your resume, remember to **CLICK THE SAVE BUTTON ON EACH PAGE** before moving to the next section. If you do not click the Save button, you may lose any information you just entered.



How do I find the AA Resume Builder?:

- When you log in to Workamper.com, you are taken to your Dashboard. On your Dashboard, click on Resume Builder.

Why I should make and update my resume:

- Works for you 24/7/365
- Email your resume to anyone (and it logs each send)
- Easy, step-by-step tool to create and maintain your resume
- Employer members can search the database to view and save resumes

The AA Resume Database is not open to the world. Only Employers who invest in a membership have access to search the database and view resumes. When communicating with an Employer, it would be best to email your resume to them instead of asking them to search for it - it will be less work for the Employer, and the Employer may or may not have access to the database.

Tab 2 - Applicant. Enter your contact information, additional info on best time/way to contact you, and your RV type and length.

Tab 3 - Availability. This section should be updated as soon as you have taken a Workamping job. Enter in the next date that you are available for and what season.

Tab 4 - Settings. Select the types of businesses you are interested in, salary/benefits and schedule preferences.

Tab 5 - Locations. Select the U.S. states and Canadian Provinces you would like to work in. *Please don't select a state unless you really will work/live there starting on your Availability Date.*

Tab 6 - History. Create an entry for each of your previous Workamper experiences. If you're a couple, you can do one entry per experience and include both of your positions.

If you are a Platinum member, you have the additional bonus of requesting to have each of your History entries verified by WKN. Check the box, enter the requested info, and submit. WKN will contact the employer to verify you worked there during the dates you entered. Having verified references done by a third party helps you stand above the rest!

If you want to list references for Employers to contact directly, type that into your Sell Yourself section.

Tab 7 - Sell You. Type up a few paragraphs about you (and your partner), what you're looking for, your skills, etc. You can type up this section in a word processing program so you can have it saved on your computer. To copy/paste in your text, please click on the button in the editing toolbar that has a small clipboard and letter W icon. Paste your text into the window that opens, and then click Insert. Then use the editing toolbar to add formatting like bolding, bullets, etc.

To spellcheck your text, click the "ABC" with checkmark button in the editing toolbar. You can change words based on the checker's suggestions or ignore them.

Tab 8 - Photos. [optional] You can have up to three photos. We recommend a close up, a photo of you in front of your RV, and a photo showing your entire RV (with tow/towed vehicle too if you have one).

The upload tool will automatically re-size the photos for quick-viewing. If you are using a mobile device, you should be able to select photo files from the photo library on your device.

If you have trouble and your photos will not upload, try re-sizing your photos to be smaller before uploading if possible. For assistance, contact WKN.

Click on Choose file to find a photo where it is saved on your computer. Click on the Upload button and once one photo uploads successfully, you'll have the option to upload another. You can remove any photo you've uploaded, and you can change the order of your photos by clicking on a photo and dragging it above or below another photo.

Tab 9 - Video. Create an "icebreaker" video. Record yourself(selves) introducing you and giving a quick overview of what you can offer to the Employer. This allows an Employer to get a better feel for who you are - better than what just text and static photos can do.

Upload your video to YouTube or other video-housing service. Copy the shareable link to the video and paste it into the field here. This will then display your "icebreaker" video below your photos and above your Sell Yourself text.

We recommend updating your resume every other month. **Any resumes that have not been updated within SIX MONTHS will be hidden from employer searches.**

Situations Wanted Online (SWO)

Put Yourself Out There

Members can “jump up and down” in front of Employers and share why they would be a benefit to them by posting an online Situations Wanted Ad (SWO).

When you submit your SWO ad, it will be displayed to Employer members logged in to the website for 2 months. (If you need your ad removed sooner, just email/call the WKN office.)

Your online ad can be up to 75 words. Describe your skills, where you want to be, when you want to start, and if you have any specific needs. Be sure to include how you want Employers to contact you. You can also check a bubble to include a link to your AA Resume (the link is generated for you automatically).

Use the online form to submit your SWO ad. You will receive an email confirmation once your online SWO ad is posted (your ad goes into our admin tool and we’ll look over it before making it active).

You can view your submitted SWO ad too. When you are logged in to Workamper.com, go to the Situations Wanted Ad Submit page and you’ll see a link for “Your current SWO”. This page will show your current SWO online ad, as Employers see it. If you need to edit your SWO ad, copy the text, go back to the SWO form, paste your ad text in the box and make any changes and submit.

You can run one SWO ad at a time, as often as you like throughout the year.

On your Manage Account page, you can view your SWO and SW print ad history.

Situations Wanted Ad

Situations Wanted Ads allow you to advertise yourself and let Employers know that you are looking for a certain employment situation!

All Situations Wanted Online (SWO) ads will be reviewed by a WKN staff member before being posted to the Employers' View SWO Ads page.

Your online ad will run for two months from the approval date. You can come to this page to submit a new ad anytime, but you may only have one active SWO ad at a time. If you submit a new SWO ad while a previous SWO ad is still running, the old ad will be replaced by the new one.

Situations Wanted Online ads have a 75-word limit. Situations Wanted Ads for the magazine have a 30-word limit.

****CONTACT INFO**** You must include your contact information in your ad text or else the Employers won't know how to contact you. We won't automatically include any contact info in either the online or printed versions of your Situations Wanted ads.

****AA RESUME LINK**** In order to include a link to your Awesome Applicants Resume in your Situations Wanted Online ad, your resume must have been updated within six months from today's date. If you want to mention your resume in your print ad, you can say something like, "See my Awesome Applicants Resume #123456." (Your Resume Number is your Member Number. Employers can also find your resume by searching on your name or email.)

Hotline Jobs Daily Email

Find A Job

The main avenue for viewing Workamper opportunity listings is the Hotline. Each weekday, Employers submit Hotline ads. Once we receive and process an ad, it is immediately posted to the Hotline Jobs website page at Workamper.com (which we'll talk about on the next page).

At 4 p.m. CT, our system compiles the day's Hotline ads into an email and sends it out to members. **The Hotline email is sent to you from hotline@workamper.com** Please put this address in the address book/safe senders section within your personal email account to help ensure deliverability.

The Hotline Daily email preference will automatically be turned on for you when you become a member. You can turn the preference on/off via Manage Account page. **Please note:** There is no Hotline ad archive available on our website. But, you can create your own archive by creating a folder in your personal email program, and putting the emails in there. Then use the search option within your email program if you are looking for a past ad with specific criteria.

Hotline Job Alert Emails

D&P Members Only: If you are in “job search” mode, the Job Alert Emails are a feature you will want to take advantage of. Be one of the first to know about the new, available positions! As soon as we publish a new Hotline ad (anytime between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. CT), you can receive an email containing that new ad.

Via the Manage Job Alert Emails button on the Dashboard or the link on your Manage Account page, select the states you are most interested in to receive Job Alerts for just those states. You can also still receive the main Hotline Jobs email in the evening containing all of that day's Hotline ads.

How do I find it: Emails are sent to the email address on your membership.

Why I want to use it:

- Quickly review new opportunities; don't have to go to a website
- **Geo-targeting available.** Receive ads for only the states you're interested in! Select your states after turning ON the Job Alert email option.

To turn Job Alert emails on/off, click on the Manage Job Alert Emails button on the Dashboard, or click the link in the Communication Preferences section on the Manage Account page.

Hotline Jobs Website Page

Find A Job

Not only do we provide the most information with our Workamper help wanted ads, but we also give our members the most search capabilities to narrow down the posted opportunities to the ones that are a closer match to their preferences.

Each weekday, Employers submit Hotline ads. Once we receive and process an ad, it is immediately posted to the Hotline Jobs website page at Workamper.com. These are the ads that are included in the Hotline Jobs Email and Job Alert Emails that we discussed on the last page.

The website page displays only the Hotline ads that were published within the last 14 days, so you know you are always looking at the most recent opportunities. Each ad displays a published date.

When an Employer is submitting their Hotline ad, they are required to fill out some general information fields. The information they include is displayed with their ad and enables members to more quickly search and see if an opportunity may be a match.

We have 10 different search criteria options plus 2 ways that a member can sort their search results. By default, the ads are shown to you with the most-recently published ad at the top.

- State location the job is in *(select one or more states)*
- RV site available
- Other housing available
- All hours paid
- Other compensation available
- No monetary compensation *(if you're looking for just a tradeout for RV site)*
- Job start date *(select immediately or any months)*
- Solos considered

Hotline Ad Features

Note 1:

Employers write their own help wanted ad text and determine what contact info to share. Only a few Employers elect to create an Employer Tour and/or Featured Employer page.

Note 2:

If the advertising Employer has existing Workamper Experiences posts or PYE star awards, you will have direct links to access them. If nothing exists for that Employer yet, these links won't display.

Note 3:

Multiple Locations -- Be sure to check this "state" section too! Multiple Locations is for Employers that have opportunities in more than one state. The location you are seeking to be in may be here! Also, Employers who offer remote (not location-dependent) jobs are included here too.



Workamper News magazine was published bi-monthly (six times a year) until 2022. The online version is a PDF file that you open and view in your internet browser. You can go through every page, zoom in/out, save the whole thing to your computer, print any page, and do keyword searches. You can go online any time of any day to view an online issue.

On the issue archive page, click in the box of the issue you want to open. We recommend reviewing past issues for Workamping opportunities and other helpful info.

The Online Magazine is a PDF file

- Most internet browsers support this file type and open it easily
- When you save the file to your computer, you'll need to have a program that can open PDF files, like Adobe Acrobat Reader (free) or Preview (Mac).

Save file to your computer so you will not need to go to the internet next time you would like to open it. On the issue archive page, right click on the PDF link then select "Save Link As..." – in the window that appears, select the location on your computer where you want to save the file to, rename the file if you want to, and then click the Save button. If you already have the file open, go to File -> Save As.

Below are some things you can do once you have the magazine open. Most of these options are located in the toolbar, and the toolbar location is dependent on your internet browser (you may need to put your mouse over the lower center of the page or lower right to get it to appear) and device.

Most of these options/buttons exist when you have the PDF file open in a program on your computer like Adobe Reader.

Zoom In/Out. You can zoom in to get a closer look or make the text larger for reading. Use the + and - buttons or hit Ctrl then + on your keyboard to zoom in and Ctrl then - to zoom out.

Keyword Search. If you have a stationary toolbar, you may see a box with the word Find or Search in it. This will search all the pages and allow you to click through the pages that have that keyword on it. You can also hit Ctrl then F on your keyboard to bring up a "find" box.

Print. Click on the Printer icon, or go to File -> Print.

Jump to Pages. If you know of a specific page you are looking for, you can type in that page number in the box next to the /60 and then hit Enter. Or, you can use the arrows, usually pointing up and down, to click up a page or down a page - one page at a time.

Researching an Employer

This tool is a great starting point for when you are researching an Employer you have interest in working for. The Employer Tour provides a visual introduction to the Employer's location and environment they provide.

Employer Gold members to WKN can create an Employer Tour, which includes a description, their logo, and 6 photos with captions.

We encourage Employers to upload photos that show off the working and living environment at their location; i.e. if it's an office job, show behind the desk, and show an RV site so you'll have a better idea if the environment would be right for you.

When you come to the Employer Tours page, you'll see a list of all current Tours. You can sort the list by clicking on the column headers - Employer, City, State, Category. Click on the name of the Employer to open that Tour.

When viewing a Tour, click on a picture to see a larger view of it and the caption (if provided). Use the arrow buttons to switch between the photos.

Click on the back to employer tours button to go back to the full list of Tours. We hope this tool will come in handy, especially if the Employer does not have a website.

Researching an Employer

When in Research Mode

Praise Your Employer (PYE) is a tool where all the info comes from you, the Workamper!

When you are researching an Employer, search for them in PYE to see if other Workampers have had a positive experience with them in the last 2-3 years, and then contact those Workampers for more info.

Search for an Employer by company name, city or state. Type in the company name or city or select a state, and click on the Search button. You can also sort the list by clicking on the column headers - Employer, City, State. In the main display, it will show you the Employer name, any stars awarded and the date the last star was awarded.

Click on a red star award to (possibly) see the email address of the Workamper who awarded that star. Then click on the email address to send that Workamper an email with a request to share more info. In your email, please try to ask some specific questions and include your name and email address so they can more easily reply to you.

Not finding the employer you are researching in the list? Check the spelling or try searching just on the city or state as a Workamper awarding a star may have spelled the name incorrectly. Or, this may mean it has not been a positive experience for others, but please be sure to do thorough research!

Posts can be positive (POS), negative (NEG) - or both - or be a warning (WRN), or asking questions (INF).

You can do searches, and view all of the posts you personally have made. Your posts can be edited or deleted at any time. A date shows with every post, and posts may or may not have the name/email of the poster. The poster has the option to share just his/her member number to remain anonymous.

How do I find it:
 At Workamper.com click the Workamper Experiences button on your Dashboard. Or click the Workamper Experiences link whenever it's included with a Hotline ad in the email or website page.

Why I want to use it:

- Read about other Workampers' experiences with the employer you're researching.
- Request info about an employer if there's nothing yet posted.
- Share your experience with other Workampers to help them out in their future job hunting.

When in Research Mode

WE is an avenue for Workampers to share about their experience with a specific Employer. Posts are made by fellow Workampers, and remember, what is right for one may not be right for another so read, ask additional questions, and do an individual evaluation of the info presented and the poster of the info.

A post can be about a positive, negative, good, or not-so-great experience. Start by clicking the View Company Listings link. Use the provided fields to search to find out if there is an existing topic on the Employer you're researching.

If there is an existing topic, click on the employer name to go into that topic to view the posts within it. If you'd like to add to the discussion or ask questions, you can use the fields toward the bottom of the page to add a post.

If not, you can create a new topic asking for information; click on the Add Company & Post link, fill out the required fields, then click the Save button.

Post titles include the feeling of the experience - POS (positive), NEG (negative), WRN (warning) - as well as the state and the employer name, so it's easy to quickly identify the general feeling of the poster.

At the discretion of the Workamper who posted the experience, he/she may have elected to show their email address with their post. You can then contact them directly with any questions you have.

Share YOUR Experience

When you come to the WE tool, please read through the instructions, and then use the links at the top to navigate.

Click on View Company Listings to search and see if your employer is already listed. The topics, by default, are sorted so that the topics at the top of the list have the most recent posts. Use the fields provided to search the list, or sort by clicking on the column headers.

If you find an existing topic, please post within it. If not, please click the link to Add Company & Post. You have the option to share your member number, your name, your email address or all of the above with your post.

Any topics or posts made in the Workamper Experiences tool must be approved by an administrator before the post will appear live on the site. You will be sent an email if your post is disapproved with recommendations on how to revise your post so it can be published.

NOTES ABOUT WORKAMPER EXPERIENCES:

- All posts made will be reviewed by an administrator before being published.
- Poster has the option to show name/email address/member number with a post.

Employment Verification

Workcamper News will verify your past Workamping jobs from the last two years on your Awesome Applicants Resume.

You will submit a request to us to verify a Work History entry on your resume. We will then contact the Employer via the contact info that you provide us. We will confirm with the Employer that you worked for them for the time frame that you entered. If the Employer confirms this information to be true, that entry in your Work History section will show "Verified: Yes."

Employers are regularly searching our Awesome Applicants Resume Database to

help fill their staffing needs. Employers usually prefer to see work history or references on resumes. If this information is already on the resume, the step of having to request this information from the applicant is removed.

Then, taking that a step further, showing that these Work History entries have been verified by a third party - well, that's basically a shining star on your resume. It is more likely that you will be contacted because you have taken the extra time to save the Employer some time.

Our Employer members have different criteria fields in the resume database that they can use to narrow down their results. One of the criteria is a checkbox to only show resumes that have verified Work History entries. You want your resume to show up as often as possible, so having verified Work History entries will help insure that happens.

This is all done in the Resume Builder tool. Go to the History tab/section of the Resume Builder. Here is where you add your previous Workamping jobs and where you'll check the box to submit a request to verify an entry. Note - It may take WKN staff up to a few weeks to get these verified since it requires direct communication with the Employer.

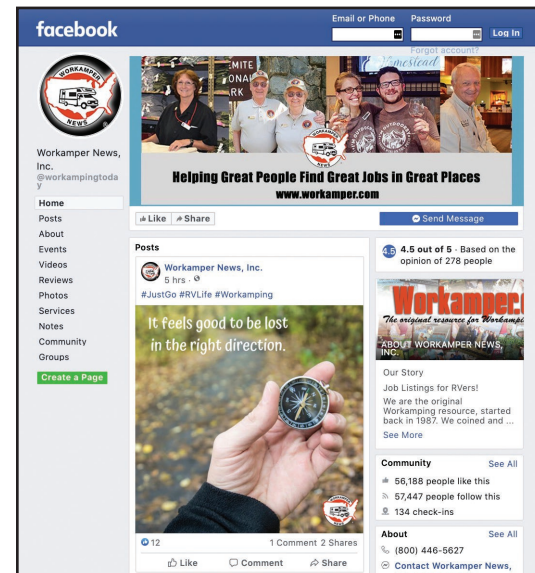
